

BPC-157 DOSING PROVIDER GUIDE

The chart below shows various dosing options coupled with the amount (in mg) and frequency for each dose. Dosing should be determined by the physician on an individual patient basis.

Reconstitution Instructions for our 5mg, 10mg, and 20mg vial

Amount in Vial	Bac Water	Amount	Unit
5 mg	1mL	250 mcg	10 units
5 mg	2mL	750 mcg	30 units
10 mg	2mL	250 mcg	5 units
10 mg	1mL	750 mcg	15 units
15 mg	2mL	250 mcg	2 units
15 mg	2mL	750 mcg	7 units
